Camp Rules

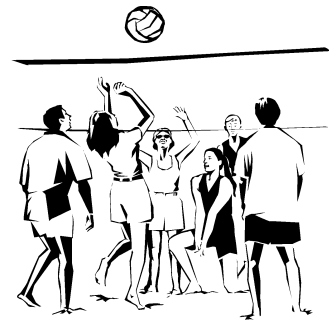
- Everyone is expected to follow the daily schedule and cooperate fully in the camp program.

Typical camp schedule

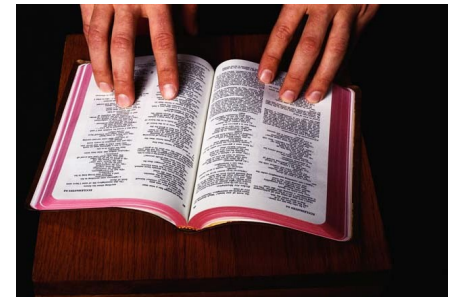

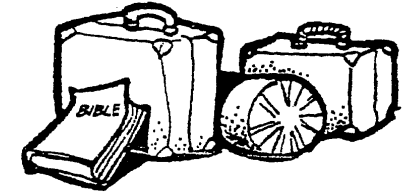

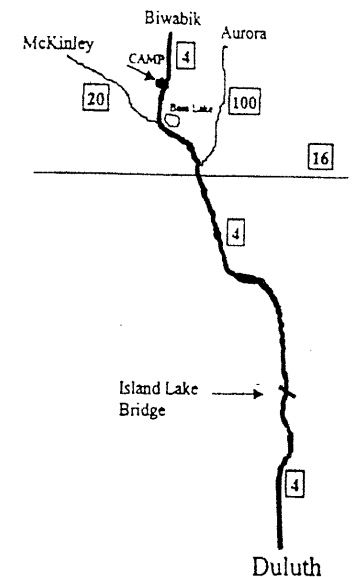


WHAT TO BRING:
